Now boarding is not always required. It is not required when:

- 1. Under renovation actively in progress.
- 2. Unoccupied Buildings listed for sale with a real estate agent and after settlement waiting to be occupied. Gas and electric utilities must remain on, lawns mowed, curtains in windows, and appliances in place. Maximum time frames; dwellings 1 year. Commercial for three months.
- 3. Vacant buildings who owner occupant is on active military duty.
- 4. Seasonal or second homes.
- 5. When boarding is prohibited by local ordinance.
- 6. When upper floors vacant but not accessible, while the first floor is occupied.
- 7. Redevelopment proposals to buy, renovate and sell real estate.
